Khambhat in Gujarat on the boil again; SP, Dy SP shunted

Vadodara: Fresh violence broke out in the coastal town of Khambhat in Gujarat's Anand district on Tuesday as a mob set a house and a shop ablaze in Mohan area of the town. No injuries were reported.

The fresh round of violence broke out after a public gathering was organised by Hindu Samaj near Tower Bazar area in the heart of Khambhat town. Following the rioting, state home department transferred Anand superintendent of police Mikrand Chavan and Khambhat's deputy SP Reena Muthal. Three police constables were also shunted with immediate effect by the DGP's office.

'Hindu Samaj' had called a torch on Monday following which shops and businesses in all markets of the town remained closed. A large number of people, however, joined the public gathering.

The gathering was not organised by a social or political organisation. Residents of Dhruvdevi area, where rioters had looted around 25 households apart from damaging vehicles, had appealed to people to come out in support of those affected in the rioting, said former BJP MLA from Khambhat Sanjay Patel. Patel, along with Khambhat city unit head of the BJP Pankaj Bhatnagar, was among those who addressed the gathering at Tower Bazar.

"The bandh was successful as shops, which were owned by Muslims or Hindus, remained close during the day," said Patel.

The town has been on the boil since Sunday following communal clash between members of minority and Chamara communities in Akbar pura area. As the violence, which began in Akbar pura, spread to other parts of the town, around 30 houses and shops were set ablaze and about a dozen vehicles were damaged by rioters.

The town again witnessed violence late on Monday evening when a police party raided Lal Durwan area to arrest rioters wanted for Sunday's communal clash. Around 60 cops were injured after a mob attacked them. One of the constables fractured his hand.

Police have arrested 47 people in connection with Sunday's rioting which had left 13 persons injured. The rioters had also damaged a mosque and a temple.

One company of Rapid Action Force (RAF) was deployed in Khambhat after Sunday's fire-rising. Policemen have begun patrolling sensitive areas and are obtaining CCTV footages to nab the accused, many of whom are on the run after theories.

Want old NPR & no NRC, says Bihar assembly in one voice

1st NDA State To Oppose Update Of Citizen Rolls

Patna: Bihar became the first NDA-ruled state on Tuesday to unanimously adopt a resolution to implement the National Population Register (NPR) in the state in its 200 format, including only the transgender column from the new format. The assembly also adopted a resolution that the "National Register of Citizens (NRC) is not needed in Bihar".

The resolution on the NPR and the NRC, put up by Speaker Vijay Kumar Choudhary with the consent of the ruling and opposition parties, was adopted unanimously much to the discomfiture of the BJP members, who failed to oppose it.

"It was essential for the smooth functioning of the House. If a resolution is adopted unanimously that means it

the common view of all the members and this situation is always desirable," Choudhary later told TOI.

Speaking on the resolution, CM Nitish Kumar clarified in the assembly that the Centre had sought the opinion on NPR from all states and his government had sent a letter commending its position on both NPR and NRC. It was this letter that was adopted as the resolution in the assembly.

"Bihar government has already communicated to the Centre that NPR format should be the same as it was in 2000 and only the transgender column

PM Manmohan Singh and other Congress leaders in Parliament demanding Indian citizenship for the persecuted minorities in the neighbouring countries.

The "unanimous" resolution, however, was a nod of political consensus as the government claimed that the government bowed to RJD pressure and JD(U) ally BJP which failed to oppose the resolution, denied that the government bowed to RJD pressure.

BJP state vice-president and Balaikrupur MLA Mihlesh Tiwari told TOI, "PM has himself clarified that there has been no discussion on NRC, as of now. So discussing the issue is like celebrating the manna of a baby before birth. Tiwari should not feel elated as BJP never deviates from its principles and it is the party which has forced a country like Pakistan to shut down."

Political observers feel that the opposition fell in the government's trap over the resolution, which suits Nitish, who was under pressure from the minority community to re-establish his secular credentials after joining hands with BJP again.

Avoid provocative speeches, Shah tells leaders at meet

New Delhi: Union home minister Amit Shah on Tuesday held a meeting with Delhi LG Anil Bajaj, chief minister Arvind Kejriwal, police commissioner Anuja Patnaik among others over the violence and prevailing situation in areas of northeast Delhi.

The Home Minister greeted the participation of all parties and urged them to exercise restraint, rise above party lines to tackle the situation, according to an official release.

He also urged leaders to avoid giving provocative speeches and statements which could flare up the situation.

The borders of Delhi with Uttar Pradesh and Haryana have been under surveillance for the last three days and Delhi police has been taking adequate steps, like checks and other precautionary measures in view of the upcoming Supreme Court hearing relating to issues pertaining to Citizenship Law, informed the home minister.

Shah noted that the professional assessment is that the violence in the capital has been spontaneous.

Violent clashes between rival

groups and arson continued for the second day on Tuesday over citizenship law in northeast Delhi, in which 10, including a policeman, have been killed and over 100 injured.

Several shops were vandalised, vehicles burnt and people armed with sticks and rods clashed in Bhajanspura, Chand Bagh and Karolpur Nagar in northeast Delhi in the unprecedented violence.

The home minister has urged people to desist from spreading rumours, and said that political parties should cooperate with police to quell these rumours and dispel fear among the public. He also appealed to public at large and media to com-

municate responsibly and avoid spreading rumours. He has asked the Police Commissioner of Delhi to have senior police officers present in Police Control Rooms so that rumours can be dispelled as quickly as possible. Shah spoke of the need to re-activate local peace committees and said that those committees should include representatives of all sections of society, religious and eminent local persons.

The home minister also urged political parties to ask their local representatives to hold meetings in sensitive areas and instruct senior police officers to visit vulnerable police stations at the earliest.

No provision to give compensation for riot deaths: Yogi

Lucknow: Uttar Pradesh chief minister Yogi Adityanath submitted in a written reply to the assembly on Tuesday that the state government has no provision to compensate families of people who die in "riot-related incidents".

According to Yogi's submission, 21 people died in "riot-related incidents" in the last six months. He said 400 police personnel were injured in stone-pelting by protesters while 60 cops suffered gunshot injuries.

At least 21 people were killed in violence during anti-CAA protests across UP on December 19 and 20.

The UP government has claimed that none of them died of police bullets. While referring to these incidents of violence in his speech in the assembly last week, the CM had claimed that "rioters were killed by rioters".

On Tuesday, the CM was

replying to a query by SP MLA Rakesh Pratap Singh who asked for the death toll of the people dying in riot-related incidents in the past six months and whether the state government would make any provision to compensate the families of the victims.

Yogi's statement has come at a time when the opposition has been criticizing his government on the law and order situation and the handling of anti-CAA protests. Yogi had earlier ordered issuance of recovery notices to the protesters who damaged public property during violence.

The CM also submitted that crime against women rose between 2017 and 2018 but these cases were brought down in 2019. In a written reply to SP MLA Ujjwal Raman Singh, the CM said that 51,382 cases of crime against women were registered in 2017. This figure rose to 53,608 in 2018 but came down to 49,867 in 2019.

SC to hear plea on lodging of Delhi violence FIR today

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Tuesday agreed to hear an application, filed by former chief information commissioner Wajahat Habibullah and others, seeking direction to the police to lodge FIRs on the complaints regarding the ongoing violence in Delhi over the Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA).

The application was mentioned for urgent listing before a bench of Justices S K Kaul and R M Joseph, which said it would be heard on Wednesday. The bench is already scheduled to hear two pleas seeking removal of protesters from Shaheen Bagh, the epicentre of agitation against the CAA for over two months.

The fresh application, filed by Habibullah, Binim Arany chief Chandrasekhar Azad and social activist Bahadur Abbas Naqvi, has also sought direction to the authorities to provide adequate security and ensure safety of women protesters at Sha-

heen Bagh and other places in the national capital. They have already filed an intervention application in the top court in the pending plea seeking removal of protesters from Shaheen Bagh.

In their fresh application, they have alleged that on February 25, "Kapil Mishra, who is known for making speeches with violence and vandalism, carried out a pro-CAA rally next to the Maujpur-Babarpur metro station which is 2 km away from peaceful protests that were going on at Jaffraabad."

Referring to media reports, the application alleged that Mishra first gathered supporters near the Maujpur-Babarpur metro station and in an "orchestrated move", he left the place after having incited the crowd, after which violence erupted in Jaffraabad and the peaceful protesters were forced to run for safety.

Act against those provoking people, be they Mishra or others: Gambhir

New Delhi: East Delhi BJP MP Gautam Gambhir on Tuesday condemned the violence over the amended citizenship law, and demanded strict action against anyone, including his party colleague Kapil Mishra, if they gave "provocative" speeches.

The MP also asked those protesting against the Citizenship Amendment Act to initiate dialogue with the government instead of indulging in violence.

"Whoever, no matter which party he belongs to, whether he is Kapil Mishra or anyone else, who gave speeches to provoke people, action should be taken against them," Gambhir told reporters after visiting injured police officers admitted at Max hospital in Patparganj.

He met deputy commissioner of Shahdara, Amit Sharma, ACP Anuj Jain and head constable Yashpal, who were seriously injured

on Monday during violence in northeast Delhi. Provocative speeches from anybody, whether he is from the BJP, the AAP or the Congress, are not acceptable. Strict action should be taken against them, he said.

Mishra, who had contested the recent Assembly polls on a BJP ticket, led a gathering in support of the CAA at Maujpur Chowk in the Jafarabad area on Sunday, after which violence erupted between pro and anti-CAA groups.

Delhi L-G leads wreath-laying ceremony of cop

New Delhi: Delhi's Lieutenant Governor Anil Bajaj led the wreath laying ceremony organised here on Tuesday to pay tributes to head constable Ratan Lal who lost his life during communal clashes in northeast Delhi. Union Minister of State for Home Nityanand Rai and Delhi Police Commissioner Anuja Patnaik also paid their respect to the slain policeman along with a host of other police officials here at the Shaheed Smarak Shala, New Police Lines.

"Ratan Lal's martyrdom is a huge loss to Delhi Police and I bear in whole L on behalf of the Delhi police, want to say that we in this time of grief stand in solidarity with the bereaved family," Patnaik said. Ratan Lal (42), a head constable attached to the office of the ACP Gokulpuri, died after he sustained injuries during stone-pelting at Chand Bagh. He is survived by his wife and three children.

Journos attacked in Delhi, one serious

New Delhi: A journalist with JK 26X7 news received a bullet injury and two reporters from NDTV were beaten and punched by rioters in north-east Delhi, which was wracked by fresh violence on Tuesday.

Akshay sustained a bullet injury while covering the communal clashes in Maujpur locality and is in hospital where his condition is said to be serious, said a tweet from JK26X7 channel.

NDTV said its journalist Arvind Gamschur was hit by rioters while he was at one of the spots in northeast Delhi and lost a tooth. His fellow reporter, Saurabh, who tried to shield him, was punched, it said.

Many other journalists took to social media to share tales of how they were heck-

led and some alleged they were questioned about their religious affiliations. On Monday, too, reporters had a tough time covering the violence with many of them threatened and heckled.

The death toll in the violence in northeast Delhi has climbed to nine, according to GTB hospital authorities.
